
## The Lion and the Mouse

Some days later, the lion was caught in a hunter's net. He couldn't get out.






The lion roared in anger.

The mouse heard the lion and ran to the net.


The mouse saw the lion and had an idea. She chewed on the net until it broke and the lion fell out. The lion was free.

A kindness is never wasted.




