an action that happened in past without telling any time



Form

have
has + P.p
I have played tennis in the club.
He has eaten pizza.



Negative

have
has + not + P.p
They haven't been to KSA.
Maria hasn't taught French.
We have never drunk pepsi.

Have you ever won the prize?
When has it rained here ?

already – yet – ever – never – since - for

Past continuous

Usage
happening at

We use the past continuous to describe past actions
the same time as another action.

Form

Was
Were + verb + ing

I was playing while you were sleeping.

Negative

was
were + not + verb + ing
They weren't studying while I was speaking.
